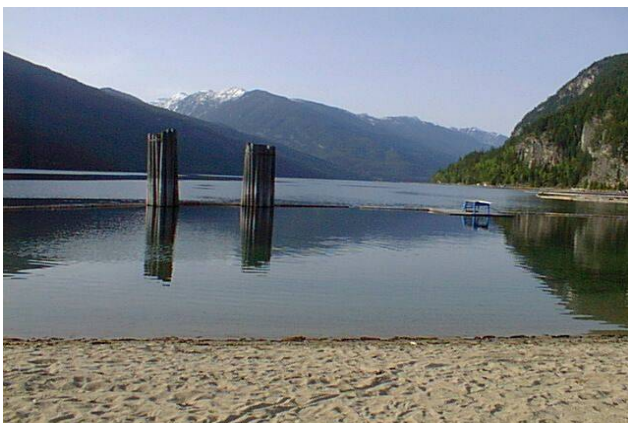

Council have been receiving numerous complaints of dogs running at large. Council has responded by arranging for bylaw enforcement. Dogs will be picked up and transported to the pound in Nelson. Dog owners will be required to pay the impoundment fees, transportation costs, and outstanding license fees to the Village before the dog will be released. Owners will be required to pick up their dogs in Nelson. Please keep your dogs at home or on a leash!

BOULEVARDS:

The Village Office has been receiving numerous complaints about abandoned vehicles on the Village boulevards. Notices will be sent out to owners to move these vehicles; if they are not moved within the required timeline, arrangements will be made to have them removed by the Village, and the owner will be billed.
