DOGS: Animal Control Now in Effect

Please be mindful that dog control is now in effect; it is important to keep your dog on a leash or inside the boundaries of your yard.

Our animal control officer is an existing public works employee who has been assigned the task of picking up dogs that are roaming loose within Slocan. This Council decision was made for the protection and safety of animals, and in response to complaints from the public.

When a dog is picked up, it is transported and held for the day at our kennel in Slocan. Administration staff is immediately informed and a great effort is made to try and locate the owner. It is very helpful when the dog has a licence as we then have the owner's contact information needed. Because we don't have proper facilities in Slocan to house a dog overnight, we are forced to transport the dog to Nelson. Arrangements have been made for approved facilities in Nelson to care for the animal until it is claimed. Impoundment and licensing fees must be paid at the Village before the dog can be picked up.

Council would like to assure you that the officer will only be picking up dogs that are loose and roaming around. Dogs in their yards or on a leash are perfectly fine.
