## VILLAGE OF SLOCAN MEETING NOTES: December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2013

Malin Christensson, representing the WE Graham Community Service Society spoke on their plans to establish a community vegetable garden to ensure fresh produce to the food bank. The community garden is to be located south of the Skate Park.

Denise Dufault attended the meeting to discuss the possibilities of developing a community micro-hydro co-operative project on Springer Creek.

Village Council agreed to provide a \$50.00 Christmas bonus and a free 2014 annual pass to the Fitness Centre for each member of the Slocan Volunteer Fire Fighters / First Responders.

The Council Procedure Bylaw requires that Council designate members of Council to serve, on a rotating basis, as the member responsible for acting in the place of the Mayor when the Mayor is absent or otherwise unable to act, or when the office of the Mayor is vacant. The following calendar was approved for the appointment of Acting Mayors for 2014:

- Councillor Elliott January, February & March
- Councillor Lunn April, May & June
- Councillor McGreal July, August & September
- Councillor Patterson October, November & December

Village Council confirmed the following dates for the 2014 Regular Council Meeting.

Councillor Elliott was appointed as the Village of Slocan Director to the West Kootenay-Boundary Regional Hospital District Board; and Mayor Perriere was appointed as the Alternate Director the West Kootenay-Boundary Regional Hospital District Board.

Councillor Elliott was appointed as the Village of Slocan Director to the Board of the RDCK; and Mayor Perriere, was appointed as the Village of Slocan Alternate Director to the Board of the RDCK.

Village Council agreed to send letters to Ministers Bill Bennett and Pat Pimm supporting the independence of the Agricultural Land Commission as a Provincial agency responsible for the Province's land use zone. Council reaffirmed its support for the preservation of farmland in the Province's Agricultural Land Reserve; and if another review of the ALC and the ALR is deemed important by the Provincial Government, a substantially longer period be afforded to local governments to scrutinize any proposed changes to the ALR and the ALC.

Due to lack of a full Council. Council tabled the following items:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of the Village of Slocan Special Events Bylaw, No. 635, 2013
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd readings of the Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 637, 2014
- the DRAFT Freedom of Information and the Protection of Privacy Policy.

Correspondence was received from Joyce Johnson, Slocan Valley Historical Society, requesting approval for kiosks at proposed sites for a self-guided walking tour. Council tabled a decision pending a full Council discussion.

Council agreed to circulate an acute care planning strategic initiative information package prepared by Jim Gustafson on behalf of the Village of Castlegar. The City of Castlegar wishes to introduce to the local government WKBRHD partners a draft strategic plan regarding the future of investment in acute care planning for the region. A public meeting will be scheduled for January 2014 for further discussion and the development of a Village of Slocan position on acute care.
