VILLAGE OF SLOCAN

MEETING NOTES: August 13, 2018

- Due to conflicting dates for the Annual UBCM Convention, Council changed the September meeting date from September 10th to Monday, September 17th.
- Council granted the Slocan District Chamber of Commerce Health Committee \$2,100 from the RDCK Community Development Fund, as Slocan's contribution to the Committee's 2018 physician recruitment efforts.
- Council approved the CIP/AAP 2017 change of scope request for the WEGCSS Learning Center Computer Lab Upgrade Project.
- Council authorized Recreation Sites & Trails BC (RSTBC) to develop the Delany Avenue Right-of-Way between Blocks A and B intersecting Main Street, to allow access for proposed parking; and further, that asphalt is the preferred resurface method.
- Council authorized RSTBC to develop a path on a portion of Village Main Street Right-of-Way between Park Avenue and Fitz Avenue, adjacent to the existing Rail Trail, where the Historical Society's Marriwake Boat will be located. Staff will draft and sign an encroachment agreement.
- Council introduced and gave first, second and third readings to the "Village of Slocan Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw (2019-2021) No. ____, 2018".
- The Zoning Amendment Application for Lots 17-20, Block 26, to consider permitting temporary residential use, was referred to the next meeting of Council, and staff were directed to provide further information regarding split use/seasonal use.
- The Zoning Amendment Application for Lots 11-14, Block 23, to consider permitting more than one accessory residential unit per 4-lot site in the Core Commercial Zone, was referred to the next meeting of Council.
- Public Works were directed to remove the damaged business/information sign from the highway as soon as possible, and Council will consider replacement of the sign during 2019 budget discussions.
- A "Dogs on Leash" sign will be placed at the entrance of the Owl Walk.
- Staff will look into the cost of cleaning the vents at the Wellness Center.
- Staff will provide Council with a summary of the Curling Club to date, and that the future of the building be discussed during 2019 budget discussions.
- The CFO's Quarterly Financial Report was received for information.

To qualify for Office, you must be a Canadian Citizen, 18 years of age or older, resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the nomination papers are filed, and not disqualified by law.

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS:

RESIDENT ELECTOR – Must be 18 years of age or older on general voting day; resident of BC for at least 6 months; resident of Slocan for at least 30 days; and not disqualified by law. **NON-RESIDENT ELECTOR** – Must be 18 years of age or older on general voting day; resident of BC for at least 6 months; not disqualified by law; and must be a registered owner of real property in Slocan. If more than one individual is a registered owner of real property, only one individual is entitled to vote with the written consent of a majority of all other owners.

FULL FIRE BAN

Open Burns are prohibited throughout the Southeast Fire Center.

On April 1, 2016, increased fines for a variety of wildfire-related violation tickets came into force. British Columbia now has some of the highest wildfire-related violation ticket fines in Canada. The B.C. government has taken a tougher stand on irresponsible behaviour that contributes to increased wildfire risks, in an effort to protect communities, natural resources and infrastructure from wildfire damage.
