The system is used in the case of an emergency or disaster that requires you to take action; whether that means you need to evacuate or shelter in place.

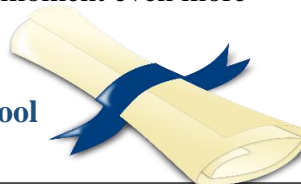

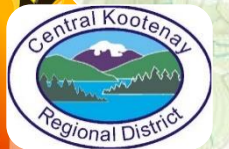

# VILLAGE OF SLOCAN MEETING NOTES – July 12th, 2021

- Mike Hurley, WE Graham Community School Principal, presented an update to Council on the pump track, and discussed potential future phases of the project.
- Council adopted the West Kootenay 100% Renewal Energy Plan.
- Council approved the CIP/AAP Grant extension request received from the Slocan Fitness Center Advisory Commission, for their 2020 Equipment Upgrade Project.
- Council gave first three readings to the “Village of Slocan Permissive Tax Exemption Bylaw (2021-2023)”, and staff were directed to post notice in accordance to section 227 of the *Community Charter*.
- Council received the July Public Works Report, July CAO Report, and report on beach vandalism.
- Council directed staff to investigate the rain barrel initiative program.

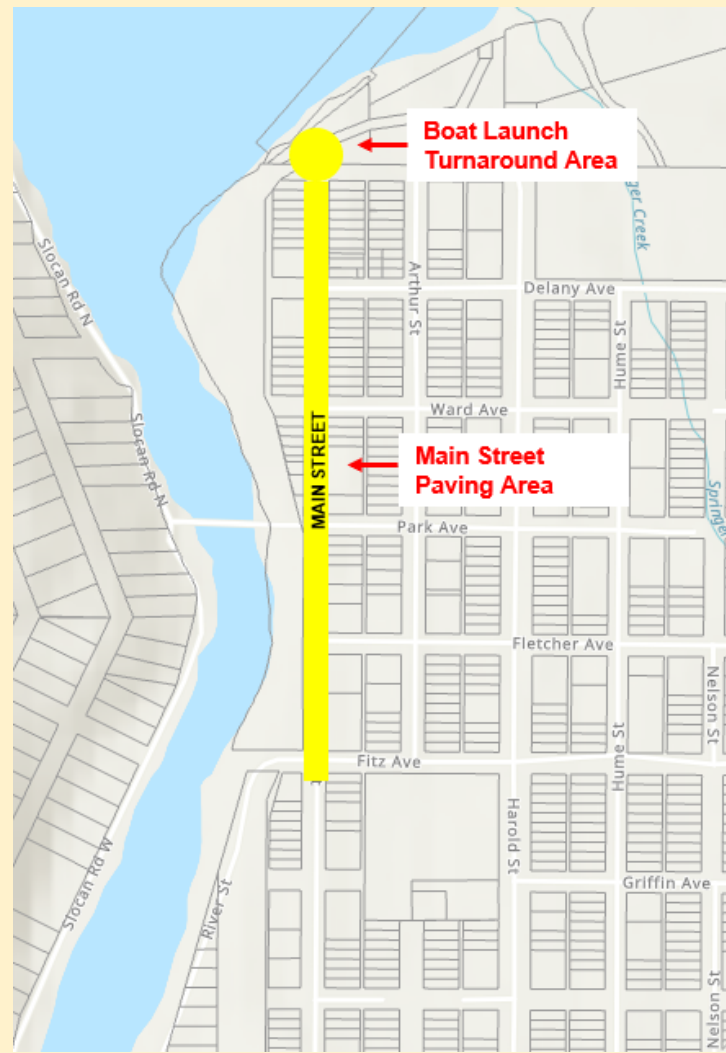
## MAIN STREET PAVING PROJECT UPDATE

During the week of July 19<sup>th</sup>, Selkirk Paving conducted road resurfacing within the Village along Main Street and the boat launch turnaround area. The boat launch was closed temporarily, and no issues were reported.

SPL worked closely with residents to ensure notice was delivered, access to properties was maintained, and that traffic control was conducted.

Selkirk Paving will be back in Slocan during the week of August 3<sup>rd</sup> to complete the necessary shouldering work.

In the coming weeks, Village Public Works will begin restoration of the boulevards. Topsoil will be brought in and spread, and in the Fall, will be re-seeded.
