This includes (but not limited to) lawn mowing, weed-whacking, gardening (planting/weeding/watering), brush-trimming, and seasonal garbage collection.</p> <p>Additionally, Labourers will provide support, as needed, for various other public works tasks such as residential garbage collection, painting, minor repairs, graffiti removal, and assistance with other projects related to municipal infrastructure and services.</p>
