

VILLAGE OF SLOCAN MEETING NOTES

April 8th, 2024 - Regular Meeting

- After the 30-day comment period, and receiving letters in support of the application, Council will recommend to the Liquor Regulation Branch, that the Lobby's Grill's application for Food Primary Entertainment Endorsement be approved.
- The Village will once again partner with the Village of New Denver and SIFCo, on an application to the UBCM CRI FireSmart Program, to continue FireSmart programs and activities within the communities.
- Council will contribute a \$300 RDCK Discretionary Grant, to the 2024 Earth Day Event at Ripley's Gardens.
- Council approved the request from the Grizz Food Truck, in principle, to operate the food truck on Village-owned property, 602 Harold Street, from May to October 2024, subject to the terms of a successful Licence to Occupy Agreement, and subject to the following information being brought back to Council for final approval: confirmed water connection plan and associated costs; confirmed power connection plan and associated costs; and confirmed grey water plan and associated costs.
- A letter will be sent to Recreation Sites & Trails BC, in support of the Slocan and Area Trail Society's application to secure authorization under the Forest and Ranges Practices Act (FRPA) for their existing trails along Springer Creek Road and Ponderosa Road, through a Section 57 application.
- · An emergency meeting will be scheduled with Council and Recreation Sites & Trails BC, to get an update on the status of the Trailhead Project.
- CBBC and the Minister of Citizen's Services will be invited to meet with Council to discuss fibre connectivity for Slocan Village, and to get an update on the Slocan Valley Last Mile Fibre Project.


