QUESTIONS:

1. Can you provide pump information, such as make/model/ filters, and is it in working order?
 - The Village acknowledges a pump is required as part of the irrigation system. The Village will supply a pump as recommended by the consultants. Details on make and model of the pump will be provided once acquired.
2. The proposed budget does not seem feasible, will my bid be considered if it's over budget and uses alternative approaches to what is specified?

- The Village acknowledges the budgetary constraints of the proposed project and is amenable to alternative approaches and proposals that exceed the proposed budget.
 - Red Shale is optional, a grass infield will be considered as an alternative.
3. There are discrepancies in *'Appendix D'* in regard to quantities specified, how should I proceed?
- The Village acknowledges discrepancies in *'Appendix D'* and will no longer require Appendix D to be completed as part of the proponent's successful bid.
4. Does the perimeter need to be secured by fencing, or will caution tape do?
