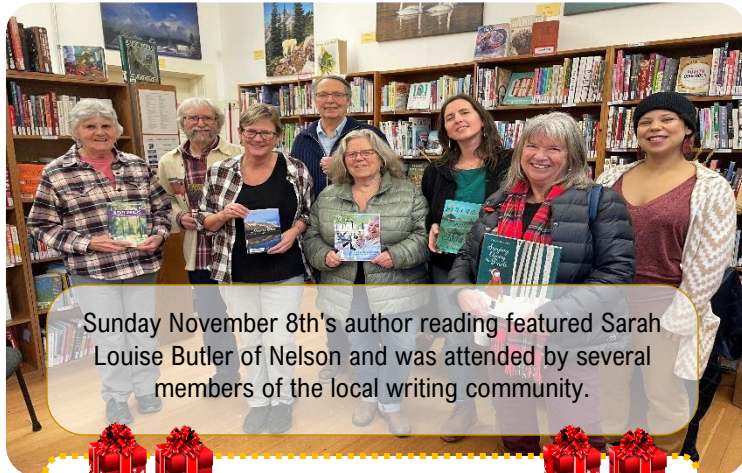

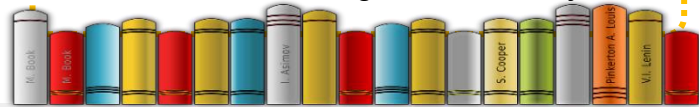


Sunday November 8th's author reading featured Sarah Louise Butler of Nelson and was attended by several members of the local writing community.

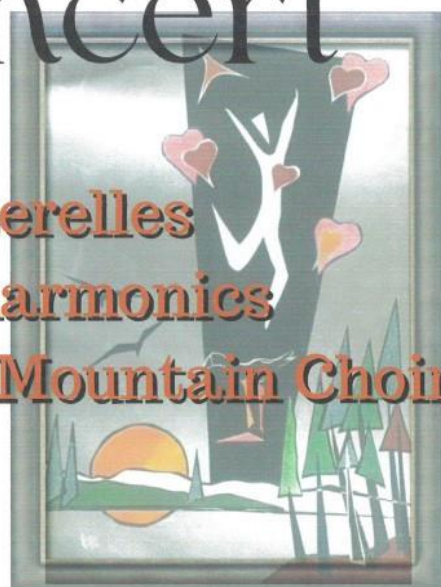

VILLAGE OF SLOCAN NOTES – November 2025

- Nathan Russ, CFO, attended the meeting to present the Quarterly Financial Report.
- The 2025 Springer Creek RV Park & Campground Operator's Report was received, alongside the financial report of revenues and expenses, and recommendations for the 2026 camping season. Staff will investigate potential rate increases for 2026, and schedule a special meeting to discuss the 2026 contract.
- The Village Office will be closed from 9:00am on Monday, December 22nd, 2025 until 9:00am on Monday, January 5th, 2026 for the holiday season. An ad will be placed in the Valley Voice Newspaper and public posting places to notify the public.
- Council awarded \$500 to the Slocan Fire Department as the Village's contribution towards their annual Christmas celebration, and will provide each member with a complimentary annual Slocan Fitness Centre pass for 2026.
- Council supported the continuing partnership with the Village of New Denver, in an application to the *UBCM CRI FireSmart Community Funding & Supports Program* for funding of up to a combined maximum of \$550,000 for a two-year program delivery for both Villages, to be administered with support from the Slocan Integral Forestry Cooperative (SIFCO). Authority was granted to the Village of New Denver to be the project lead in applying for, receiving, and managing the grant funding on behalf of the Village of Slocan.
- A \$2000 grant was approved from the RDCK Community Development fund for the 2025 WEGCSS Christmas Holiday Hamper Program.
- Council consented to the RDCK "Slocan Valley Transit Local Service Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 3035 and 3036".
- Council requested the Village Traffic and Highway Regulation Bylaw be brought forward to the next Council meeting for review, to determine enforcement for items left on boulevards that impede snow removal.
- A letter will be sent to CBT, supporting the Legion's application to the Accessibility Grant Fund.
- Staff were directed to review the original breakwater proposal, to compare the initial project plan to the end result.
- Council discussed concerns with the breakwater. The Breakwater Proposal will be reviewed to compare the initial project plan with the end result.

SNOW REMOVAL

SNOW REMOVAL Winter weather is coming and the Village would like to remind residents to keep boulevards clear of unlicensed vehicles and debris, in preparation for snow removal. Persons with disabilities and seniors may apply for **Clearance of Driveway Furrows** at the Village Office. Proof of eligibility is required for new applicants—recurring applicants can re-register by phone: **250-355-2277** *This is a complimentary service, and furrows are cleared after all other plowing has been done. If you require more immediate assistance with furrow removal, we recommend contacting a local contractor.*
