Adopt Agenda
2026/44 Moved by Councillor Van Bynen, seconded by Councillor Perriere,
And Resolved:
That the agenda be adopted as presented.

Recommendations:
Mill Site Loan
2026/45 Moved by Councillor Knott, seconded by Councillor Perriere,
And Resolved:
That Council make a one-time payment of \$400,000 from the Village's
Operational Surplus Reserve, to the mill site loan; AND,
2026/46 That staff be directed to initiate the process of applying to the Municipal Finance
Authority for Long Term Borrowing of 10 years or less,

2026/47 Moved by Councillor Knott, seconded by Councillor Perriere,
And Resolved:
That staff be directed to investigate Village-owned lands which may be suitable
to dispose of, to reimburse borrowing from the Operational Surplus Reserve to
pay the mill site loan.

Campground Contract
2026/48 Moved by Councillor Knott, seconded by Councillor Perriere ,
And Resolved:
That staff be directed to issue a Campground Contract Request for Proposals
for the 2026 camping season; AND

That the Contract terms be amended to include the Parks Washroom
Maintenance Contract; AND

That the total maximum Contract amount payable for the 2026 season be
\$41,475, and will be paid out as follows:

- up to 1334 allowable working hours at twenty-five dollars (\$25) per hour, for operation of the Campground (\$33,350);
- up to 325 allowable working hours at twenty-five dollars (\$25) per hour, for maintenance of the parks washrooms (\$8,125).

2026/49

And Resolved:

That the Term of the Campground shall be for one year, with the option to renew for a maximum of two further years, subject to submission of a year-end report, performance review, and Council approval at the end of each contract season;
AND

That the Contract mandatorily be re-posted for tender at the end of each 3-year term, unless the current contract is terminated by either party at an earlier date, at which time the Contract will be re-posted.
