VILLAGE OF SLOCAN MEETING NOTES – June 8th

- Council approved a \$500 RDCK Community Development Grant for 2026 WE Graham Community School grad gift bags.
- Paris Marshall Smith presented on the Slocan Lake & River Partnership.
- Councillors Buller and Knott will be attending the 2026 UBCM Convention in Vancouver, BC, on September 14th to 18th, alongside Mayor Lunn as voting delegates representing the Village of Slocan.
- A letter of support will be sent to the Province and Local MLA's, outlining the need for continued Local Government Climate Action Program (LGCAP) funding.
- The 2025 Statement of Financial Information (SOFI) and 2025 Annual Report were approved as presented.
- The existing Waterfront Plan will be consulted to find a suitable location for a resident-proposed climbing dome.
- The Village of Slocan Local Government Election Procedures Bylaw 2026 was adopted.
- The Village of Slocan Local Government Election Officials Bylaw 2026 was adopted.
- Council has accepted a donation of trees and plants from Ripley's Gardens. Staff will work on a plan for placement.
- Council has directed staff to look into the scope of Village projects that potentially align with the criteria of the CBT's new SHORE Grant Program.
